Judy is from California and later moved to Canada. It was cost prohibitive to bring hydro to her country home and because she wanted to begin a retirement business, Judy became interested in solar energy. Her home has modern appliances, all run on solar energy. However, she does use propane for large load items such as freezer and stove. The mounts for the panels are no longer limited to rooftop. They can be a ground mount or a pole mount. Judy gave a long list of items which have been developed to run from solar energy: campers, boats, floating docks, pond aerators and emergency call boxes on highways. Judy showed us a variety of items she has available for retail sale: waterproof flashlight, radio, battery re-chargers, path markers and model cars that run.
