The TV Auction kits are out. Same format as last year and 2% of the gross goes to Rogers.

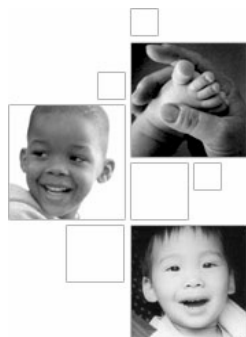
**80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary**

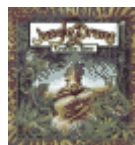
