Mary Ellen spoke on the "Wild Water" Program that targets about 2000 children, mostly in grades 4 and 5, about the dangers of playing on frozen lakes and rivers and the hazards of playing next to these bodies of water when "spring is sprung". Students also receive hands on training with hockey sticks and snow shoes to learn how to use them as tools to get out of the water.
