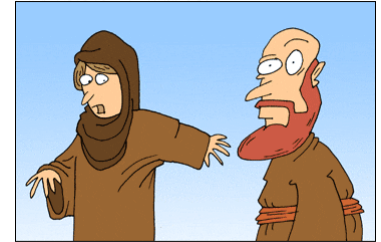
Auction
