Dr. Lynn says it is an exciting time to be the MOH.

Her programs include **Preventing:** work in the communities, families and individuals and **Protecting** all of us from hazards in the air, water and soil.

Things that fall under the scope of work that Dr. Lynn oversees are: dietary needs; drug and alcohol abuse; planned and new babies; SARS; Nile

mosquitoes; heart disease; water safety, which includes drinking water and safe beaches for swimming; vaccinations; rabies shots; sexual health issues, mostly with teens; car seats; safe toys; dental care and family violence.

When Dr. Lynn first came to Owen Sound and became the MOH she set as a goal to establish bylaws to eliminate smoking in restaurants, bars and other public areas. Now that she has accomplished this goal, her next target is obesity and getting people to participate in fitness programs at work and elsewhere. (Look out S Stew!).
