BEYOND HEART BREAK HILL- WILKINSON'S MARATHON EXPERIENCE

Past President Don Sweatman introduced guest speaker, Don Wilkinson. Don attended University of Western Ontario and McMaster University. He has a degree in physical education and is a Registered Massage Therapist. Prior to telling us about his marathon experience, Don acknowledged the assistance he and his wife Michelle received from the Kiwanis Club of Owen Sound at a time when one of their children was very ill. Don has completed 3 marathons and trains 5 days a week. Don describes the Boston Marathon experience as a "defining moment." It is a significant event as you personally face the demands, difficulty and the strain by yourself. It is extremely well organized and the acoustics are thunderous as 18,000 runners participate and whole villages cheer and support from the sidelines. His adrenalin and the enthusiasm of the spectators led him to a time of 3 hours and 28 minutes, which is below his qualifying time. A runner's time is tracked by a computer chip placed inside the runner's shoe.
